Depot Events: Karla reported that February at the Depot will feature the theme “Feathered Friends” which seems to be themes for both the city artwalk and valley shows. Karla said that May will feature the artwork of Kris Strell and outlined details of the show.

Madrona Grove Sculpture Exhibition: Three of the existing pieces in the show have sold, two of which will become public art. Donations are being sought to purchase a fourth piece, Garden Party for Eve and Patty by Lucy Mae Martin. That artwork would remain at the Depot along the south side of the building. A permanent plaque for the piece was discussed. Peregrine has volunteered his work to be placed elsewhere on loan and Betsy will seek a location. It was decided that the Call for Entries for the 2019 Madrona Grove Exhibition should be resent. The entries are due Feb. 26, jury during week of March 4 and installation early spring. An email will also be resent to artists that have work onsite for the current show. Betsy will work on the letter to Windermere for 2019 funding of the exhibition.

Other Business: Marius reported that the student show at the Croation Cultural Center was a success with 12 prints being sold. Prints sold for \$75, with the student retaining \$50 and \$25 to the charity of their choice. Jim Thompson and Chris Terrell were thanked for their contributions to the event.

Lanny stated that he is working on a show at Skagit Valley College Gallery in March that will honor his late wife, Eve Deisher
