You can use the OverDrive app for Windows 8, to get eBooks and audiobooks from your library digital collection on your Windows 8, RT, or 10 device..


Step 1. Install the OverDrive app from the [Windows Store](#).

Step 2. Open the OverDrive app and follow the prompts to sign in (or signup) using your library card or a free [OverDrive account](#).

Step 3. In the OverDrive app, select the [Add a library](#) button, then follow the prompts. Once you find your library, click or tap its digital collection (Washington Anytime Library) to save it to your “My libraries” list and start browsing.

Step 4. [Borrow a title](#) (you'll need to sign into your library's digital collection to complete this step).

Step 5. Once you've borrowed a title, select 

To go to your Loans page and see your options for the title. From there, you can:

- Select **Download**, then select:
- **EPUB eBook** to download [EPUB eBooks](#) to the app **Bookshelf**.
- **Kindle Book** (U.S. only) to [complete checkout on Amazon's website and send the book to your Kindle device or Kindle reading app](#).

- Select **Download** to download [MP3 audiobooks](#) to the app **Bookshelf**.
- Select **Read in browser** to open [read-alongs](#) or [eBooks](#) right in browser.
