Supplies:

Kleenex box	Scissors & Tape
Toilet & Paper Towel rolls	Paint for toilet paper rolls
Dixie paper cups (large & small)	Hot Glue Gun
Two books you want to recycle	Sticks for flags

This castle is a display castle. Your castle will tell a story with the materials that you use. Have fun using your imagination in creating this fun display castle.



Recycled books



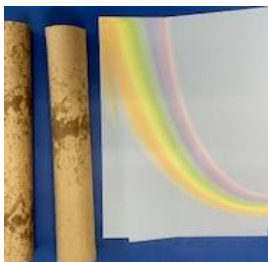
Open book to middle and glue pictures you cut from books. Glue all pages together and hot glue to the front and back with a little lift of the pages.



Remove plastic from opening in box. Cut the back open so you can insert picture.



Find a picture or color one that you can glue into the back of the box. Close box and tape shut.



Cover paper towel with paper or color.



Cut bottom of cups and cut top to make towers.



I used old headbands to decorate the towers.



Place towers next next to box and hot glue.



Paint or decorate toilet paper rolls. Small dixie cups fit right inside the toilet paper roll.



Take your box with the towers and the toilet paper rolls and place them on a piece of cardboard. Trace around them to create a base for your castle.



This is what my base looked like after I cut it out. I then hot glued everything to the base.



Everything should be hot glued to the base before you attach it to your open book.



Don't forget to make some awesome flags!



Hot glue your castle to your open book and you have an amazing castle to put on display!
