

# The Three Bear's Castle – Storytime 7/6/2020



## Supplies:

| Pool Noodles                  | Permanent Markers           |
| Cardboard                     | Scissors                    |
| 2 Milk Cartons                | Paint                       |
| Toilet Paper Rolls            | Hot Glue Gun                |
| Foil                          | Stapler                     |
| 2 Red Solo Cups               | Knife (to cut pool noodles) |
| Q Tips & Paper Cupcake Liners |                             |

This is a pull apart castle! You can keep adding more rooms with pool noodles and cardboard walls and foil milk carton towers. It is fun to make and take apart because you can rebuild it differently every time!



64 oz milk or juice carton  
Cut off top.



Cover carton with wrinkled foil. Cut Solo cup following pattern on cup.



Paint or color toilet paper rolls and cut out three towers.



Cut and paint paper plates. Form into a tower and staple.

Use Q Tips or paper clips for your flag poles. I used tissue paper and paper cupcake liners for the flags. You can hot glue to flag pole and towers.



Cut cardboard and paint and decide if you want to cut notches in the top of the walls.



Decide how tall you want your towers. Cut 2 slits (as tall as your wall) into the pool noodles so you can join the walls.

The fun part of making the castle is deciding how to paint the walls and towers. How many windows and flags will you add to your towers? Many castles have names. Think of a name and add that somewhere on your castle. HAVE FUN!
